What are our objections?

- 1. **Lack of consideration** of the implications of high-rise development on the ridge-top adjacent to Lane Cove National Park
- 2. **Potential impacts** on wildlife affected by noise and light (including the Powerful Owl)
- 3. **Excessive building height of 79 metres**, the 416 Group and the Friends of Lane Cove National Park propose a maximum height of 15.5 metres
- 4. **Bushfire risk**, previous fires have been tackled by helicopters using this airspace
- Added congestion on <u>already</u> congested roads. If approved the office block will house upto 2000 people with on-site parking increasing from 175 to 502 spaces
