## **Community Fire Units**

Ku-ring-gai Council has very kindly given the Albert Drive CFUs a grant of \$450.00 for Administration costs. The grant is most appreciated by CFU Members.

The 416 Group continues to support all CFUs in the area by providing printing and clerical support.

#### **Hazard Reduction Burn-off**

In response to our enquiry, National Parks and Wildlife Service (NPWS) has advised that, depending upon the type of vegetation, hazard reduction burns are on a 5/7. 5/10, 7/12 or 8/14 year cycle. Albert Drive, Terrace Road, Carramar Road and Bradfield Road are on a 7 to 12 year cycle.

A hazard reduction burn is scheduled for Albert Drive this year. Carramar Road and Bradfield Road are Scheduled for 2012.

Residents within 200 Metres of the burn will be notified by letter drop by the NPWS.

#### **Lady Game Drive**

Council has carried out further works to Lady Game Drive between Ryde Road and De Burghs Road. These improvements are much appreciated and should improve safety, which has been a concern of residents for some time.

#### Ryde Waste Management And Recycling Centre

The sale of the NSW Government owned WSN Environmental Solutions to SITA Environmental Solutions has now been completed. The contract stipulates that current staff remain in their existing positions for a specified period and the operation will be in accordance with the existing DECCW (EPA) licence, hence no change is expected in the near future.

Over the past 3 Months there has been a drop in offensive odour and noise complaints. The Centre is a continuing source of smells and noise from Greenwaste processing and excessive noise from loading scrap metal into transport containers and It is important that both DECCW (131 555) and SITA (1 800 062 086) are notified as soon as possible after an annoying smell or noise is observed.
