

Community Fire Units

CFU members have conducted training days in the course of the long hot summer with numbers boosted after the fires causing heavy loss of property in the Lower Blue Mountains and also the bushfire in West Pymble on Nov 8th. Senior firefighter Dane Philippe has been appointed CFU officer for the CFU programme in this area and has been active with new initiatives.

There are CFU units in Albert Drive, Charles Street and Terrace Road. To activate/deactivate a CFU unit must:

- Call the CFU activation line 1800 000 238
- Have a minimum of four participants
- Appoint a leader

With the fire season ending the next induction training dates are due to be announced and will suit new residents wishing to join their closest CFU. The program takes about 5 hours and is held on a Sunday.

Ryde Resource Recovery Centre

Over the last 3 months there have been no reports of offensive odours coming from the Centre.

The Centre is now operating purely as a transfer station with no greenwaste grinding taking place. The current management has been proactive in ensuring that deposited greenwaste is moved off-site as soon as possible.

The operation of the Centre will be monitored and hopefully it will continue to be resident friendly.
